Podstata klinickej rôznorodosti ako aj rôznorodý klinický priebeh nie sú jasné. Klinická štúdia prispieva retrospektívnou analýzou k tejto problematike. Mapuje a hľadá súvislosti v klinickom priebehu pacientov s PV. ./Pemphigus vulgaris (PV) is an autoimmune blistering skin disease which is an orphan disease. The disease has heterogeneous clinical appearance and miscellaneous outcome. Clinical study contributed to this theme with retrospective analysis of patients with PV and performed research in outcome of disease in patients with PV.

Na štatistickú analýzu súboru sa použil Mannov Whitneyho test a Kruskalov- Wallisov test. Survival údaje sa analyzovali pomocou Kaplanonovho-Maeierovho testu a long rank testom. Fisherov exaktný test sa použil na potvrdenie štatistickej významnosti ($p < 0.05$). 79.5% pacientov malo mukokutánný typ PV, pomer žien: mužov a bol 1.58 a zvýšil sa na 2.8 v prípade ťažkého PV. Rozdiel medzi pohlaviami a veku vzniku ochorenia bol štatisticky významný ($p = 0.05$). Početné prejavy na slizniciach a na iných miestach sa spájali s ťažkými mukokutánnymi typmi. Početné relapsy sa vyskytli častejšie u ťažkého typu ako u mierneho typu ($p = 0.001$).
