LITERATURE:

Winter semester: 12 weeks, 2 lessons a week

1 st week	Working in general practice. Description of a GP's job.
2 nd week	Presenting complaints. First contact doctor-patient communication. Describing pain.
3 rd week	Instructions and procedures. Preparing for the first ward round.
4 th week	Patient care. Check up. Explaining medical procedure to a patient. Signs and symptoms.
5 th week	Dealing with medication. Benefits and side effects. The placebo effect.
6 th week	Lifestyle: Family history and social history. Genetics.
7 th week	Technology in medicine. Controversial developments.
8 th week	Working in psychiatry. Eliciting the medical history.
9 th week	Surgery. Working in a team.
10 th week	Emergency medicine. Describing how things happened.
11 th week	Accidents. Causes of injury.
12 th week	Revision.

Summer semester: 12 weeks, 2 lessons a week

1 st week	Internal medicine I. History taking in general. Past medical history, family and social history.
2 nd week	Internal medicine II. Medical examination. Body weight and diet. Heart symptoms.

5 th week	Neurology. Headache. Head injury.
6 th week	Dermatology. Diagnosis and management of skin conditions.
7 th week	Geriatrics. Parkinson's and Alzheimer's disease.
8 th week	Obstetrics and gynaecology.
9 th week	Tropical diseases. Travellers' problems.
10 th week	Paediatrics. Parents and children.
11 th week	Creating an Effective PowerPoint Presentation.
